Church

- Fight between Church jerarchy and anticlerical social movements (anarchism)
- Freedom of worship, secularization of cemeteries, civil marriage, divorce

Army

- Excess officers
- Obsolete equipment
- •Azaña's Law: commands swear loyalty to the Republic, abolition of the Law of Jurisdictions, right of withdrawal with full pay, reorganization of units (suppression of the Military Academy of Zaragoza -Franco director)
- Creation of the Assault Guard: republican national police urban -
- Modernization of the Army

Education

- •Decrease illiteracy and increase the cultural level
- •Constitution of 1931: compulsory education, free and laic
- Creation of schools, high school centers, teaching training
- Pedagogical Missions

Land

- Avoid unemployment in the field [through the settlement of day laborers on the expropriated lands]
- Distribute the land [expropriating the large "stately" farms and the large estates in the hands of absent owners]
- Rationalize the agrarian economy [reducing the growth of the cereal surface and returning to the rural its old communal property, lost with the seizures of the nineteenth century] ".
- •IRA (Agrarian Reform Institute)

Authonomic Issue

- Constitution: Comprehensive state and autonomy of municipalities and regions
- Creation of Statutes of Autonomy endorsed by its citizens
- •Catalonia approves the Statute in 1932: Generalitat (Parliament, President, Advisory Council); assignment of competences; Republican Left, F. Maciá succeeded by Ll. Companins
- Failure of the first Estaturio Basque project, Statute of Estella of 1932, (annexation of Navarre). Lastly approved in 1936 during the Civil War
